Scholarship support is provided according to need on a means tested basis.

This includes scholarships funded by the Li Po Chun Charitable Trust Fund and the Sir Jack Cater Scholarship Trust Fund. Scholarship support is provided according to need on a means tested basis.

The number of scholarships and destination colleges is subject to change and to confirmation by the scholarship donors, except for places at Pearson College (Canada) and Adriatic College (Italy) which are full (100%) scholarships regardless of financial need.

Please note that in applying for a scholarship, students are applying to the UWC Movement, not an individual college, and the Selection Committee reserves the right to offer a place in the College of its choosing according to availability, preference and need.

Students should apply for entry during the year before their 2nd last year of studies at their present school, for entry to commence at the beginning of the 2nd last year of their present high school's programme. Please note, however, that **some** overseas UWC have minimum age requirements (usually 16 at the time of entry).
