

Capacity Enhancement Grant Proposal 2020-2021

The 2020-21 academic year will see several developments that will be supported by the Capacity Enhancement Grant.

Following last year's introduction of distance online learning, a model of Blended Learning Approaches will be further developed. To support this online model, the college WiFi network will be enhanced to maintain consistent and stable internet access from the entire campus with no weak points and/or blind spots. Such enhancements will be covered by this year's grant.

The IT Developments Phase 2 will resume with a focus on the search of eLearning platforms which will best support our new model of Blended Learning. Such expansions and/or replacements will be funded by this year's grant.

In addition, the continual improvement of the provision of minor or subject specific eLearning applications and software will also be supported by this grant.

Criteria for Evaluation:

- Checklist of demands/needs from all stakeholders within college, from academic to admin to residential;
- Survey of existing software/systems in the market;
- Comparison of several selected products within our budget constraints
- Survey of staff and student preference(s) of selected products;
- Recommendation for 2020-2021, including budget requests.
